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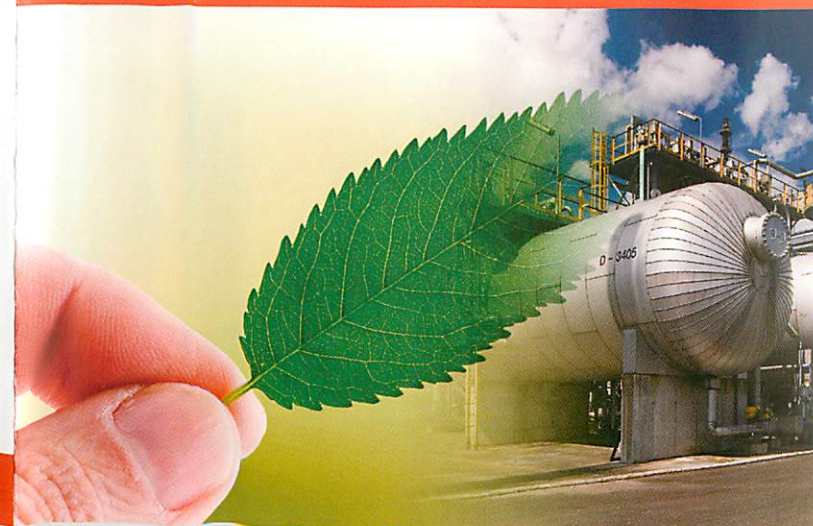

REACH

The EU regulatory framework REACH (Registration, Authorisation, Evaluation of Chemicals) entered into force on 1 June 2007. REACH affects 'new' and 'existing' substances.

Manufacturers, importers and to a certain extent downstream users of existing substances (on the market before September 1981) are enforced to register all substances of a production / import volume exceeding 1 t/a. Each registration submission will consist of a Technical Dossier and, for substances above 10 tonnes, a Chemical Safety Report (CSR). Failure to register will mean that the substance cannot be manufactured or imported.

Substances must be pre-registered between 1st June and 1st December 2008 (inclusive) in order to benefit from extended registration deadlines.
